Unfortunately we are experiencing a considerable amount of viruses in nursery including **coughs and colds or sickness and diarrhoea**. These illnesses **get passed on easily** to other children and adults too. We strongly advise that children are kept at home if they are unwell for their own well being and also to prevent the spread of any illness. Our policy recommends that children stay at home **for 48 hours** following sickness or diarrhoea; however we would appreciate it; **where possible** that you **consider 72 hours in order to clear your child completely of illness** before they return to nursery. We appreciate this may cause inconvenience however it will assist with the prevention of closure should we find ourselves short of staff. Please be reassured that closure will only be considered as a very last resort.
